These are courses set by the National Registry according to what all providers nationwide need to know <u>currently</u>.</p> <p>Make sure courses meet the NR content (don't just plug any course you take with the same name into this area unless the instructor confirms it meets the required content.)</p> <p>You may take all of these hours "bundled" as well.</p>	<p>These are courses that MA providers typically take as "mandatory training" with their service. Examples include: Protocol updates, ALS/BLS Interface, Interfacility Transfer, Stretcher Operations, Restraints, MOLST, Stroke Point-of-Entry, Trauma POE, STEMI POE, BLS Glucometer, Albuterol, Naloxone, Selective Spinal Assessment, BBP/PPE, HIPAA, M&amp;M Rounds</p> <p>Contact your Training Coordinator or the Region if you need help choosing a course for this category.</p>	<p>Take any OEMS or CAPCE approved EMS course of interest to you.</p> <p>Once you've completed the Local category credits, you can roll excess credits into this category.</p>
